**The 15th Annual International Conference on Development Studies
Sustainability: Climate Action, Just Transition and the Future of the Ocean**

Date and Time: October 28 (Sat) to October 29 (Sun) , 2023

Venue: National Taiwan Ocean University

Theme

Environmental issues related to climate change, including global warming, heavy rainfall, heat waves, fires, severe typhoons, sea level rise and seawater overflow, have caused many natural disasters and loss of human life and property. Taiwan is surrounded by the sea and its major population agglomerations and industries are mostly concentrated along the coastal plains. The extreme climate brought about by climate change will definitely have an impact on the use of Taiwan's sea and coastal space and industrial development. Therefore, the question of how to mitigate the severity of disasters, utilize marine resources sustainably, preserve the cultural assets of port cities and ensure fair and equitable transition and design adaptation strategies in the process of net-zero transition is a pivotal issue that all of humanity must address.

Accordingly, the conference will be themed on climate change action and sustainable oceans. Scholars and PhD students from different disciplines are cordially invited to participate in the conference, which will focus on three major issues: 1. social science-driven net-zero transition; 2. interdisciplinary perspective of the ocean; 3. coastal fishing villages and harbor urban governance, etc., to jointly construct social resilience and adaptation strategies from different perspectives or scales.

Multiple sessions

1. **Topics Related to Climate Change:** Action research for just transition, climate services from knowledge to action, gender and climate change, indigenous peoples and climate change, energy transition and net-zero living.
2. **Topics Related to Sustainable Oceans:** Sustainable fisheries, Marine transportation and sustainable development, offshore fisheries and transnational governance, marine science and technology governance and risk management.
3. **Topics related to Coastal Villages and Harbor Cities:** Marine culture and local revitalization, fishery religions and faiths, coastal belt environment and sustainability, planning and operation of marine sports and tourism and regional

- development driven by cruise ships, etc.
4. **Topics Related to University Social Responsibility (USR) :** University social practice and humanistic innovation, university and community or local government interaction, USR advanced introspections and exploration, etc.
 5. **Global Governance, International Development and Cooperation:** International NGOs, international governmental organizations, development assistance, international cooperation, international political economy, transnational regional economic integration.
 6. **Spatial Planning and Development in the Post-Pandemic Era:** National land use planning, land justice, social housing, urban and regional studies, leisure industry, local tourism and recreation planning, etc.
 7. **Environment and Sustainable Development:** Sustainable transition, energy transition, global climate change and adaptation, agriculture and rural revitalization, environmental resource management, disaster and risk management, etc.
 8. **Group Relations and Cultural Development:** Cultural asset revitalization, cultural and creative industries, the ethnic group issues, indigenous studies
 9. **Social Innovation, Health and Well-being:** health care, education policy, community building, aging society, human rights, poverty, gender issues, social welfare, generational justice, etc.
 10. **Other development studies topics not covered above**

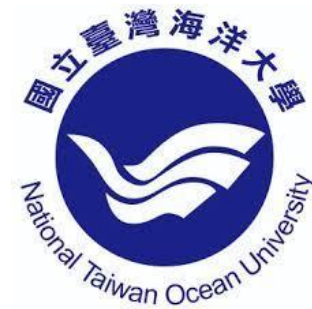
